- Maximum number of job-seekers (64.5 Lakh) awaiting employment were in West Bengal, while minimum (0.06 Lakh) were in UT Dadra & Nagar Haveli and (0.2 lakh) in the State of Arunachal Pradesh.
- Placement was maximum (5.6) Thousand in Gujarat, where as registration was maximum (67.1) Thousand in Madhya Pradesh.
- Placement was 9.3% of Submissions made by the employment exchanges.
- 25.9 % of the total job seekers were Women.

(Organised Sector consists of all Public Sector establishments and the Private Non-Agricultural Establishments employing 10 or more workers.)

- There was a marginal decrease of 0.22% in the Employment in the Organised sector during quarter ending December 2001, as compared to September 2001.
- Public Sector contributed about 68.4% to the Total Employment in the Organised Sector.
- The participation of women in Public and Private Sectors was of the order of 15.3 % and 25.0% respectively. The over all participation of Women in employment in the Organised Sector was about 18.3%.
