

**Sub: Draft Notification of Nomenclature of Field Institutes under DGT to be placed on E-Gov portal for suggestion of public.**

“Advanced Training Institutes (ATIs) are running in our country for the last 50 years and conducting Crafts Instructor Training Scheme (CITS). There are 14 institutes imparting training in 34 trades of long term and more than 100 no. short-term courses in Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics, Computer, IT and Automobile streams. These courses were skillfully designed for students passing out from ITIs, polytechnic, Engineering, college etc.

The NVTI (National Vocational Training Institute) and RVTIs (Regional Vocational Training Institute) are institutes built across country to impart vocational training to women in sectors like beauty, wellness, fashion, administration, food and beverages, architecture, etc. There are 18 Institutes running/15 regular courses under Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) and Craft Instructors, Training Scheme (CITS).

The names of above mentioned Institutes are Advanced Training Institute (ATI), Foreman Training Institute (FTI), Advanced Training Institute for Electronics and Process Instrumentation (ATI-EPI), Apex Hi – Tech Institute (AHI), National Vocational Training Institute for Women (NVTI) and Regional Vocational Training Institute (RVTI). These multiple names create confusion and do not clearly define the goal oriented objectives of the institutes. Though all the Institute of DGT conduct skill based Training courses but the skill ingredients are not getting reflected in nomenclature.

In view of above, it is logical to propose that there should be uniformity and clarity in the nomenclature of the institutes, so that it caters to the work synergy and culture of skill ecosystem prevailing at international level.

It is proposed to rename all the Institutes uniformly as “National Skill Trainers Institute”. In case of NVTI and RVTIs catering to skilling of women, the same are proposed to be named as National Skill Trainers Institute (Women).

Views and suggestion are solicited in this regard.
