
**Subject: Approval of Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) courses for Chemical and Plastic Processing Sectors converted from Centre of Excellence (CoE) courses - regarding**

**Sir/ Madam,**

This is to inform that the meeting of 'Sub-committee of NCVT on Norms and Courses' was held on 17<sup>th</sup> July, 2015.

2. Sub-committee approved the implementation of curricula of following CTS courses/ trades for Chemical and Plastic Processing Sectors converted from CoE courses:
  - a) Instrument Mechanic (Chemical Plant)
  - b) Laboratory Assistant (Chemical Plant)
  - c) Maintenance Mechanic (Chemical Plant)
  - d) Attendant Operator (Chemical Plant)
  - e) Plastic Processing Operator
3. The courses mentioned in para '2' above are already running under Craftsmen Training Scheme. The old/ existing syllabi of these five CTS trades implemented from August, 2013 will be applicable for trainees admitted w.e.f. session August, 2014.
4. Henceforth, the revised curricula for these five CTS trades will be applicable for the trainees admitted w.e.f. August, 2015 as well as for the trades of Chemical and Plastic Processing Sectors converted from CoE courses.
5. The revised curricula implemented w.e.f. August, 2015 for the trades mentioned at para '2' above will be available on [www.dget.nic.in](http://www.dget.nic.in).
4. Accordingly, Directors of all the States and Union Territories dealing with Craftsmen Training Scheme are requested to issue further necessary instructions to all Government and Private ITIs, affiliated to NCVT, of their respective State/UTs to follow the revised curricula for these five trades.

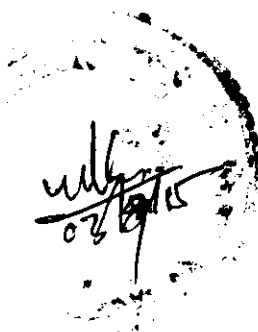
