You were requested to submit a single Cheque/Demand Draft of all the students appearing in AITT examination, semester wise.

In this regard, it is regretted to inform you that so far no fees has been received from your State/ UT's for the students likely to appear in above mentioned examination. You would appreciate that deposition of examination fees is mandatory, failing which DGE&T will not be in a position to supply the question papers to the Sates/UT's.

In view of above, it is requested that exam fee must be deposited latest by 12th January, 2015. In the event of the student failing to appear in the above examination because of the reason mentioned above then the responsibility will lay on the concerned State Directorates/ UTs dealing with Craftsman Training Scheme.
