Subject: Generation of Hall Tickets for First Semester trainees appearing in the forthcoming AITT under CTS from Feb 20, 2015 – NCVT-MIS Portal reg.

Sir / Madam,

As you are aware that the students admitted under CTS in August 2014 will appear in first semester of All-India Trade Test commencing from February 20, 2015. Based on the data received from the states, hall tickets have been generated through NCVT-MIS portal and provided to the States. Examination centre wise Roll Sheet of all candidates whose details were uploaded in the portal till February 18, 2015 (mid night) have also been generated and download links have been provided to the states.


2. It is expected that the State Directorates have downloaded the hall tickets provided as PDF files, or generated from the NCVT-MIS portal as per detailed instructions provided vide letter of even number dated 4th Feb 2015.

3. It has been brought to the notice of this office that there are a few candidates whose details were uploaded after the hall tickets were generated on the portal, and hence, their hall tickets are not available for download. To provide hall tickets to such candidates whose details are available on the portal but the hall tickets are not available for download, the State Directorate is hereby empowered to issue hall tickets at their end with details as available on the portal. It may be noted that the roll number on such hall tickets must be the same as that available on the Roll Sheet already provided. If the roll number is not available on the Roll Sheet, the same can also be obtained directly from the public portal of NCVT-MIS. Visit the Trainee Search page (<http://www.ncvtmis.gov.in/Pages/Trainee/Search.aspx>) to search the appropriate ITI, and note the Registration Number of such candidates appearing on the portal. The roll number of the candidate will be the same as Registration Number displayed on the portal, with the letter "R" replaced with "00" (two zeroes).

4. It has been decided that all candidates whose data is not available on the NCVT-MIS portal will not be permitted to appear for the AITT. The DGE&T will provide a final opportunity to upload the data of such candidates until 19:00 hrs on 19th February 2015. No affiliation changes will be entertained during this window. The hall tickets for additional candidates that will be uploaded today shall be processed as per ^{para}3 above.
